
# The Impact of Obesity on Health: 7 Statistics and Trends

#### **OBESITY THROUGH THE DECADES**

Over the past 30 years the proportion of adults who are obese and overweight has risen from 52.9% to 63.7%




ADULT OBESITY


25.9% of adults in England are obese and a further 37.8% are overweight

### THE COST OF OBESITY

The costs at societal level are huge. The Government estimates these at £6.1 billion to the NHS and £27 billion to the wider society.

Over one in four (26%) adults and 23.4% of children aged 10-11 years in England are living with obesity, placing huge pressure on the health and care system.





#### **HEALTHCARE UTILISATION**

Individuals with obesity have higher healthcare utilisation rates compared to those with normal weight. In England, obese individuals visit their GP about 24% more often and have about 13% more hospital admissions.
