

Three useful tips for EMIS Web users

1) Quick codes and texts

These are little time-saving shortcuts like #ssri or .safe that when activated while documenting in patients notes or sending notes to other people, will automatically add a whole sentence that you can program beforehand.





2) Searches

Searches act as safety nets, aiding patient safety, supporting audits and maximising practice income.

3) Mail Merge Variables

Users can import documents into EMIS and use Mail Merge Variables to automatically pre-fill table documents with data from the imported documents.





FootFall Dashboard is the nerve centre of your digital practice that enables the management of all requests in one central location. It provides complete tracking of actions taken, allows requests to be assigned to designated staff, and facilitates communication with patients. Due to its seamless integration with EMIS Web, clinical staff can perform the following tasks from FootFall Dashboard:

- Export episodes into EMIS Web with complete SNOMED-CT codes
- Show current patient Use EMIS to open the current patient and look at their EHR



- **Swap patient** look up previous requests that a parient has sent through FootFall
- Send patient a message by SMS/email and send a copy to EMIS, allowing a patient to reply, to send files, or requiring a patient to reply
- Send the notes from a video consultation into the patient's episode



FootFall Connect is a new additional feature that can be particularly useful for clinical staff who prefer to work on the clinical system rather than the dashboard. As of 22nd November 2023, the FootFall Connect toolbar features connect to EMIS only. They are separate from the Dashboard and are designed for clinicians/users who work mostly in EMIS Web.

The FootFall Connect Toolbar has four buttons for the most common tasks:

- Recent Requests
- Send Message
- Video Consultation
- Move Toolbar

On the right side, there's the FootFall Connect Toolbar with a highlighted "Send Message" button. When the button is clicked, the window featured below will open. From this window, you can then type a message and send it to the patient.






You can drag and drop the FootFall Connect toolbar to a position on your screen that suits you best.
